### Phase 1 – Curriculum Review & Development

- Development of Guiding Principles and Vision for Department process
- Analysis and Reflection on Research Base and impetus for change (mandated information, data review)
- Gap analysis between current and desired state
- Identification of standards, drafting of outcomes and development of enduring understandings/essential questions

### Phase 1 PRODUCTS:

Standards, EQ/EUs and Outcomes by course, grade level or grade band

### Phase 2 – Curriculum Implementation

- Further development of student outcomes
- Research, analysis and development of Common Assessments
- Implementation of standards, outcomes and assessments

### Phase 2 PRODUCTS:

Common assessments, unit plans/lesson plans (teacher level)

### Phase 3 PRODUCTS:

Scope and Sequence, refined unit plans/lesson plans, instructional resources, including formative assessment items, projects and/or performance tasks

### Phase 3 – Curriculum Revision

- Analysis and revision of formative and summative assessments
- Establishment of instructional timelines; scope and sequence
- Identification of critical instructional resources and materials
